The Governor has been pleased to introduce the following new Scheme w.e.f 1st April'2012.

1) Pension to the persons who lost 100% eye sight under APL families.


- i) The age of the applicant must be 10 years & above.
- ii) The applicant must be under APL family.
- iii) He & She must be 100% visually Handicapped.
- iv) The rate of pension will be Rs. 500/- (Rupees five hundred) per month w.e.f 01-04-2012.

Details of the scheme of the pension for the persons who lost 100% eye sight belonging to APL families is enclosed.

Pension to Persons who lost 100% eye sight belonging to APL Families. (New State Scheme).

1. Name of the Scheme : Pension for 100% eye sight loss persons belonging to APL categories
2. Targeted beneficiaries : Persons who lost 100% eye sight belonging to APL categories.
3. Other eligibility criteria : If the applicant is covered by any other Social Security Pension Scheme then he shall not be eligible for getting pension under this Scheme.
4. Rate of pension : At the rate of Rs. 500/- per beneficiary per month.
5. Projected number of beneficiaries to be covered by the Scheme : There will be universal coverage of the eligible beneficiaries.
6. Proposed date of starting the Scheme : 1st April, 2012
7. Method for application : To apply to the Child Development Project Officer (CDPO) concerned AMC / Nagar Panchayat / R.D. Block in prescribed application form, which shall be available from the office of the Child Development Project Officer (CDPO), free of cost.
8. Sanctioning authority : The Child Development Project Officer (CDPO) will sanction pension with prior approval of the Director of Social Welfare and Education.
9. Supportive documents to be attached with the application
- Attested Copy of certificate indicating that the applicant belongs to APL household, issued by the C.E.O. of the Panchayat / E.O of the Nagar Panchayat or B.D.O of the respective Block Attested Copy of EPIC of the applicant.
 - Attested Copy of EPIC of the applicant.
 - A certificate issued by the Medical Board on the eye sight may be submitted and certified by competent authority of the Department (CDPO), Chairman, Panchayat Samity, Pradhana G.P./AMC/TTAADC on complete scrutiny.
 - Attested copy of an age proof certificate issued by AMC / Nagar Panchayat / Gram Panchayat / Village Committee of TTAADC areas
10. Termination of coverage by the Scheme. : Coverage by this Scheme will be terminated automatically in case of death of beneficiary. However pension for the month in which beneficiary dies will be paid to his nominee / legal heir. The government can make any change in the scheme, as and when required.
11. Others : The government can make any change in the scheme as and when required
