TRIPURA SCHEME FOR INCENTIVE TO GIRL CHILD-2009

1	Name of the Scheme	: TRIPURA SCHEME FOR INCENTIVE TO GIRL CHILD-2009
2	Targeted beneficiaries	<p>a. Any Girl Child born on or after 1st June-2009 to parents who are Cardholders of listed BPL households. The Incentive amount will be paid to the mother of the girl child, preferably through a Bank Post Office account.</p> <p>b. In case the mother of the girl child dies before the girl child attains 18 years of age, then the father/ legal guardian will become the recipient under the Scheme.</p>
	Other eligibility criteria	Up to 2 (Two) girl children in a family will be covered by the Scheme.
3	Rate of incentive	At the rate of Rs. 300/- per beneficiary per month, up to the month the girl child attains the age of 15 years.
4	Projected number of beneficiaries to be covered by the Scheme	Up to 2 girl children of a mother in each and every BPL family who are born on or after 1st June-2009 will be covered by the Scheme up to the month the girl child attains 15 years of age.
5	Proposed date of starting the Scheme	1st June, 2009
6	Method for application	To apply to the Child Development Project Officer (CDPO) of the concerned AMC / Nagar Panchayat / R.D. Block in prescribed application form, which shall be available from the office of the Child Development Project Officer (CDPO), free of cost.
7	Sanctioning authority	The Child Development Project Officer will sanction the incentive with prior approval of the Director of Social Welfare and Social Education.
8	Supportive documents to be attached with the application	<p>a. Attested Copy of certificate indicating that the applicant belongs to BPL household, issued by the B.D.O, E.O. or C.E.O. of the respective R.D. Block / Nagar Panchayat / AMC</p> <p>b. Attested Copy of EPIC of the applicant</p> <p>c. Attested copy of Birth Certificate of the girl child issued by the Registrar of Births and Deaths, AMC / Nagar Panchayat / Gram Panchayat / Village Committee of TTAADC areas.</p>
9	Term/amount of coverage of the scheme	Coverage by the Government will be automatic / continuous till the girl child reaches 15 years of age. However, incentive for the month in which the girl child attains 15 years.
