NOTIFICATION

Whereas, the use of Aadhaar as an identity document for delivery of services or benefits or subsidies simplifies the Government delivery processes, brings in transparency and efficiency, and enables beneficiaries to get their entitlements directly in a convenient and seamless manner by obviating the need to produce multiple documents to prove one's identity;

And whereas, the Education (Social Welfare & Social Education) Department (hereinafter referred to as the Department) is administering the following welfare schemes (hereinafter referred to as the Schemes) to provide social pensions, which is being implemented through the Directorate of Social Welfare & Social Education (hereinafter referred to as the Implementing Agency (ies));

- 1. 60% and above Disability Allowance
- 2. Allowance for 100% Blind
- 3. Blind & Handicap Pension (BHP)
- 4. Pension for 80% & above physically challenged
- 5. Pension for Cancer Patient
- 6. Pension for Persons who lost 100% Eye sight
- 7. Person Living with HIV/AIDS
- 8. Social Pension for Transgender
- 9. Tripura Incentive to Girl Child (TIGC)

And whereas, under the Schemes, Social Pension (hereinafter referred to as the benefit) is given to the eligible citizens (hereinafter referred to as the beneficiaries), by the Implementing Agency as per the extant Scheme guidelines;

And whereas, the aforesaid Schemes involved recurring expenditure incurred from the Consolidated Fund of Tripura State;

Now, therefore, in pursuance of section 7 of the Aadhaar (Targeted Delivery of Financial and Other Subsidies, Benefits and Services) Act, 2016 (18 of 2016) (hereinafter referred to as the said Act), the Government of Tripura hereby notifies for the State Schemes where the beneficiaries are children the following, namely:-

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1. (1) A child desirous the benefits under the Schemes shall be required to furnish proof of possession of Aadhaar number or undergo Aadhaar authentication.

(2) A child desirous of availing benefits under the Schemes, who does not possess the Aadhaar number or, has not yet enrolled for Aadhaar, shall be required to make application for Aadhaar enrolment before registering for the Scheme provided that he is entitled to obtain Aadhaar as per section 3 of the said Act, and such children shall visit any Aadhaar enrolment centre (list available at the Unique Identification Authority of India (UIDAI) website www.uidai.gov.in) to get enrolled for Aadhaar.

(3) As per regulation 12 of the Aadhaar (Enrolment and Update) Regulations, 2016, the Department through its Implementing Agency, is required to offer Aadhaar enrolment facilities for the beneficiaries who are not yet enrolled for Aadhaar and in case there is no Aadhaar enrolment centre located in the respective District, Sub-Division or Block, the Department through its Implementing Agency shall provide Aadhaar enrolment facilities at convenient locations in coordination with the existing Registrars of UIDAI or by becoming a UIDAI Registrar themselves:

Provided that till the time Aadhaar is assigned to the child, benefits under the Schemes shall be given to such children, subject to the production of the following documents, namely:

- (a) (i) if the child has been enrolled after attaining the age of five years (with biometrics collection), his Aadhaar Enrolment identification slip, or of bio-metric update identification slip; and
- (b) Any one of the following documents, namely: (i)Birth Certificate; or Record of birth issued by the appropriate authority; Or

(ii) School identity card, duly signed by the Principal of the school, containing parents' names; and

(c) Any one of the following documents as proof of relationship of the beneficiary with the parent or legal guardian as per the extant Scheme guidelines, namely:-

(i) Birth Certificate; or Record of birth issued by the appropriate authority; Or

(ii) Ration Card; or

(iii) Ex-Servicemen Contributory Health Scheme (ECHS) Card; or Employees' State Insurance Corporation (ESIC) Card; or Central Government Health Scheme (CGHS) Card; or

(iv) Pension Card; or

(v) Army Canteen Card; or

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(vi) any Government Family Entitlement Card; or

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(vii) any other document as specified by the Department:

Provided further that the above documents may be checked by an officer specifically designated by the Department for that purpose.

2. In order to provide benefits to the beneficiaries under the Schemes conveniently, the Department through its Implementing Agency shall make all the required arrangements to ensure that wide publicity through the media shall be given to the beneficiaries to make them aware of the said requirement.

3. In all cases, where Aadhaar authentication fails due to poor biometrics of the beneficiaries or due to any other reason, the following remedial mechanisms shall be adopted, namely: -

- (a) in case of poor fingerprint quality, iris scan or face authentication facility shall be adopted for authentication, thereby the Department through its Implementing Agency shall make provisions for iris scanners or face authentication along with finger-print authentication for delivery of benefits in seamless manner;
- (b) in case the biometric authentication through fingerprints or iris scan or face authentication is not successful, wherever feasible and admissible authentication by Aadhaar One Time Password or Time-based One-Time Password with limited time validity, as the case may be, shall be offered;
- (c) in all other cases where biometric or Aadhaar One Time Password or Time-based One-Time Password authentication is not possible, benefits under the Schemes may be given on the basis of physical Aadhaar letter whose authenticity can be verified through the Quick Response (QR) code printed on the Aadhaar letter and the necessary arrangement of QR code reader shall be provided at the convenient locations by the Department through its Implementing Agency.

4. Notwithstanding anything contained herein above, no child shall be denied benefit under the Scheme in case of failure to establish his identity by undergoing authentication or furnishing proof of possession of Aadhaar Number or the case of a child to whom no Aadhaar Number has been assigned, producing an application for enrolment. The benefit shall be given to him/her by verifying his/her identity on the basis of Aadhaar documents as mentioned in the clauses (b) & (c) of the proviso of sub paragraph (3) of paragraph 1, and where benefit is given on the basis of such other documents, a separate register shall be maintain to record the same, 1. (1) A child desirous the benefits under the Schemes shall be required to furnish proof of possession of Aadhaar number or undergo Aadhaar authentication.
